Ladie's Sweater

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: approx. 4 (4, 5, 5, 6) balls (approx. 110yd/100m each) of SMC select **Pertinio** (82% cotton, 14% viscose, 4% Lurex) in col 01902 midnight and approx. 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) balls in col 01903 white. Size 7-8 [4.5-5mm] needles, size E/4 [3.5mm] crochet hook.

Garter Stitch: k every row.

Gauge: 12-13 sts and 30 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st, measured lying flat.

Sweater: is worked in one piece across shoulders, beg at lower edge of front. When working sleeves, work each block of col with separate ball of yarn. Twist yarns around each other at each col change to prevent holes. To twist yarns, drop the old col, pick up the new col from under the old col. Work first st in new col tightly. With midnight, cast on 52 (58, 65, 71, 77) sts. Work in garter st and work stripes as foll: work 38 rows each with midnight, white and midnight. Work 82 (90, 98, 106, 114) rows with white. Work 38 rows each with midnight, white and midnight. At same time, after having worked 38 rows with midnight and piece measures 15"

[38cm], shape sleeves: change to white and cast on 25 sts at beg of next 2 rows – 102 (108, 115, 121, 127) sts.

Work 8 rows each with white and midnight throughout across newly cast-on sleeve sts, work 82 (90, 98, 106, 114) rows with white across center 52 (58, 65, 71, 77) sts. At same time, when piece measures 17¼ (17¾, 18, 18½, 19)" [44 (45, 46, 47, 48) cm], shape neck: work to center 20 (20, 21, 23, 23) sts, join another ball of yarn, bind off center 20 (20, 21, 23, 23) sts, work to end. Working both sides at same time, work even until piece measures 23¼ (24, 24¼, 25¼, 26)" [59 (61, 62, 64, 66) cm]. Next, work 41 (44, 47, 49, 52) left front sts, cast on 20 (20, 21, 23, 23) sts, work 41 (44, 47, 49, 52) right front sts.

Cont in pat as established until 80 (88, 96, 104, 112) rows have been worked from beg of sleeve shaping and piece measures 25½ (26¾, 27½, 28¾, 30)" [65, 68, 70, 73, 76) cm]. Shape sleeves: bind off 25 sts at beg of next 2 rows – 52 (58, 65, 71, 77) sts. Next, work 38 rows each with midnight, white and midnight, then bind off all sts.

Finishing: sew side and sleeve seams. With crochet hook and midnight, work 1 rnd sc around neck edge.
