YARN

To fit bust

YARN

Wool Cotton 4ply
8 8 9 9 10 11 x 50gm
(photographed in Satsuma 489)

NEEDLES

1 pair 2¾mm (no 12) (US 2) needles
1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles
2¾mm (no 12) (US 2) circular needle

BUTTONS - 3

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm measured over stocking stitch using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

BACK

Using 2¾mm (US 2) needles cast on 115 [121:127:135:143:151] sts.
Work in g st for 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Change to 3¼mm (US 3) needles.
Beg with a K row, work in st st, dec 1 st at each end of 13th and 2 foll 8th rows, then on 2 foll 6th rows.
105 [111: 117: 125: 133: 141] sts.
Work 13 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 8th row until there are 115 [121: 127: 135: 143: 151] sts.
Cont straight until back meas 32 [32: 31: 34: 33: 35] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Now work in yoke patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): P0 [0: 0: 1: 2: 0], *K1 tbl, P2, rep from * to last 1 [1: 1: 2: 0: 1] sts, (K1 tbl) 1 [1: 1: 1: 0: 1] times, P0 [0: 0: 1: 0: 0].

Row 2: Knit.

These 2 rows form yoke patt.

Cont in patt until back meas 34 [34: 33: 36: 35: 37] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 4 [5: 5: 6: 6: 7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 107 [111: 117: 123: 131: 137] sts.**

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 [3: 5: 5: 7: 7] rows, then on foll 4 [5: 4: 5: 5: 6] alt rows. 93 [95: 99: 103: 107: 111] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 18 [18: 19: 19: 20: 20] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape back neck

Next row (RS): Patt 25 [26: 28: 30: 31: 33] sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 18 [19: 21: 23: 24: 26] sts.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 6 [6: 7: 8: 8: 9] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 [7: 7: 7: 8: 8] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 43 [43: 43: 43: 45: 45] sts, patt to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 [3: 5: 5: 7: 7] rows, then on foll 4 [4: 4: 3: 4: 4] alt rows. 93 [97: 99: 107: 109: 115] sts.

Work 1 [1: 3: 1: 1: 1] rows, ending with RS facing for next

row.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): (Work 2 tog) 0 [1: 0: 1: 1: 1] times, patt 35 [35: 38: 40: 40: 43] sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. 35 [36: 38: 41: 41: 44] sts.

Work each side of neck separately.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 10 rows, then on foll 3 alt rows, then on 3 foll 4th rows, then on foll 6th row **and at same time** dec 1 st at armhole edge of 0 [0: 0: 2nd: 0: 2nd] row. 18 [19: 21: 23: 24: 26] sts.

Cont straight until front matches back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 6 [6: 7: 8: 8: 9] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 [7: 7: 7: 8: 8] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 23 [23: 23: 23: 25: 25] sts, patt to last 0 [2: 0: 2: 2: 2] sts, (work 2 tog) 0 [1: 0: 1: 1: 1] times. 35 [36: 38: 41: 41: 44] sts.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 2¾mm (US 2) needles cast on 61 [61: 63: 63: 65: 65] sts.

Work in g st for 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd [3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd: next] and every foll 8th [8th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 6th] row to 81 [91: 89: 99: 97: 69] sts, then on every foll 10th [10th: 10th: -: 10th: 8th] row until there are 93 [95: 97: -: 101: 103] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 44 [44: 45: 45: 46: 46] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Cast off 4 [5: 5: 6: 6: 7] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

85 [85: 87: 87: 89: 89] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on every foll alt row to 47 sts, then on foll 15 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 17 sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred. Mark point along left side of neck 16 rows above centre cast-off sts.

Neckband

With RS facing and using 2¾mm (US 2) circular needle, beg and ending at marked point, pick up and knit 16 sts down left side of front neck, 23 [23: 23: 23: 25: 25] sts from front, 58 [58: 58: 62: 62: 62] sts up right side of front neck, 10 sts down right side of back neck, 43 [43: 43: 43: 45: 45] sts from back, 10 sts up left side of back neck, and 42 [42: 42: 46: 46: 46] sts down left side of front neck, turn and cast on 7 sts. 209 [209: 209: 217: 221: 221] sts.

Work in g st for 6 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off knitwise (on **WS**).

Slip stitch cast-on edge of neckband extension in place on inside. Using photograph as a guide, attach 2 buttons to neckband.

Pocket

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles cast on 22 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1 tbl, (P2, K1 tbl) to end.

Row 2: Inc in first st, K to last st, inc in last st. 24 sts.

Row 3: Inc purlwise in first st, K1 tbl, (P2, K1 tbl) to last st, inc purlwise in last st. 26 sts.

Row 4: As row 2. 28 sts.

Row 5: Inc purlwise in first st, (P2, K1 tbl) to last 3 sts, P2, inc purlwise in last st. 30 sts.

Row 6: As row 2. 32 sts.

Row 7: P2, (K1 tbl, P2) to end.

Row 8: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 16 times more, dec 1 st at centre of last row. 31 sts.

Change to 2 3/4mm (US 2) needles.



Work in g st for 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K15, yfwd, K2tog (to make a buttonhole), K to end.

Work in g st for a further 2 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off knitwise (on **WS**).

Using photograph as a guide, sew pocket onto front. Attach button to front to fasten through buttonhole in top edge of pocket.



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
