Yarn

14 balls of Rico Baby Classic DK

- 1 x Cream (2)
- 1 x Vanilla (3)
- 1 x Red (9)
- 1 x Petrol (10)
- 1 x Purple (16)
- 1 x Ice Blue (23)
- 1 x Turquoise (25)
- 2 x Light Green (27)
- 1 x Melon (33)
- 1 x Grass (35)
- 1 x Jeans (36)
- 1 x Clay (37)
- 1 x Smokey Rose (39)

Hook

Suggested size: 4mm / G - USA

* Remember you may need to change hook size to match the gauge given below

Materials

Yarn needle

Size

106 x 138 cm (42 x 54")

Gauge

15 sts by 10 rows in treble crochet
