CROSS OVER CARDIGAN in Wendy D.K.

Instructions given for 81 cm. (32 inch) Bust, larger sizes given in round brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt. - alternate; **beg.** - beginning; **cm.** - centimetres; **cont.**- continue; **dec.** decrease; **fol.** - following; **inc** - increase; **ins.** - inch(es); **K.** - knit; **mm.** - millimetres; **P.** - purl; **patt.** - pattern; **p.s.s.o.** - pass slipped stitch over; **rem.** - remain(ing); **rept.** - repeat; **r.s.** - right side; **sl.1** - slip one stitch; **st.st.** - stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl); **t.b.l.** - through back of loop; **tog.** - together; **w.s.** - wrong side; **y.fwd.** - yarn forward; **0** - No stitches or rows to be worked in this particular size.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment.

22 sts. and 31 rows to 10 cm. (4 ins.) over st.st. on 4 mm. Needles. If there are too many stitches to 10 cm., then your tension is tight and you will need to change your size.

BACK

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 85 (91, 97, 103, 109, 115) sts.

Row 1 (r.s.) - K.1, *P.1, K.1, rept. from * to end.

Row 2- P.1, *K.1, P.1, rept. from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 28 rows, dec. 1 st. at each end of 7th and foll. 6th row, then on 3 foll. 4th rows and ending with a w.s. row. 75 (81, 87, 93, 99, 105) sts.

Change to 4 mm. Needles.

Starting with a K. row, work in st.st. as follows:-

Cont. straight until Back measures 15 (16, 16, 17, 17, 18)

cm., 6 (6¼, 6¼, 6½, 6½, 7) ins., ending with a w.s. row. Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every foll. 4th row until there are 93 (99, 105, 111, 117, 123) sts.

Work 11 rows, ending with a w.s. row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 7) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. 85 (89, 95, 99, 105, 109) sts.

Dec. 1 st. at each end of next 3 (3, 5, 5, 7, 7) rows, then on foll. 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 7) alt. rows. 71 (73, 75, 77, 79, 81) sts.

Cont. straight until armholes measure 19 (19, 20, 20, 21, 21) cm., 7½ (7½, 7¾, 7¾, 8¼, 8¼) ins, ending with a w.s. row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 5 (5, 5, 5, 6, 6) sts. at beg. of

next 4 rows, then 5 (5, 6, 6, 5, 6) sts. at beg. of foll. 2 rows.

Cast off rem. 41 (43, 43, 45, 45, 45) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 70 (76, 82, 88, 94, 100) sts.

Row 1 (r.s.) - *K.1, P.1, rept. from * to end.

Row 2 - As row 1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 28 rows, dec. 1 st. at beg. of 7th and foll. 6th row, then on 3 foll. 4th rows and ending with a w.s. row. 65 (71, 77, 83, 89, 95) sts.

Change to 4 mm. Needles. Starting with a K. row, work in st.st. as follows:-

Cont. straight until Left Front measures 15 (16, 16, 17, 17, 18) cm., 6 (6¼, 6¼, 6½, 6½, 7) ins., ending with a w.s. row.

Shape Front Slope

Dec. 1 st. at end of next row and at same edge on foll. 20 (24, 26, 28, 30, 36) rows, then on foll. 11 (9, 8, 7, 6, 3) alt. rows and at same time inc. 1 st. at beg. of next and 8 foll. 4th rows. 42 (46, 51, 56, 61, 64) sts. Work 1 row, ending with a w.s. row.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 7) sts. at beg. and dec. 1 st. at end of next row. Work 1 row.

**Dec. 1 st at armhole edge of

next 3 (3, 5, 5, 7, 7) rows, then on foll. 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 7) alt. rows **and at same time** dec. 1 st. at front slope edge of next and every foll. alt. row. 24 (25, 27, 29, 31, 31) sts.

Dec. 1 st. at front slope edge **only** of 2nd and foll. 1 (4, 6, 11, 13, 12) alt. rows, then on 7 (5, 4, 1, 0, 0) foll. 4th rows. 15 (15, 16, 16, 17, 18) sts. Cont. straight until Left Front matches Back to start of shoulder shaping, ending at armhole edge.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 5 (5, 5, 5, 6, 6) sts. at beg. of next and foll. alt. row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem. 5 (5, 6, 6, 5, 6) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 70 (76, 82, 88, 94, 100) sts.

Row 1 (r.s.) - *P.1, K.1, rept. from * to end.

Row 2 - As row 1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 28 rows, dec. 1 st. at end of 7th and foll. 6th row, then on 3 foll. 4th rows and ending with a w.s. row. 65 (71, 77, 83, 89, 95) sts.

Change to 4 mm. Needles.

Starting with a K. row, work in st.st. as follows:-

Cont. straight until Right Front measures 15 (16, 16, 17, 17, 18) cm., 6 (6¼, 6¼, 6½, 6½, 7) ins., ending with a w.s. row.

Shape Front Slope

Dec. 1 st. at beg. of next row and at same edge on foll. 20 (24, 26, 28, 30, 36) rows, then on foll. 11 (9, 8, 7, 6, 3) alt. rows **and at same time** inc. 1 st. at beg. of next and 8 foll. 4th rows, ending with a r.s. row. 41 (45, 50, 55, 60, 63) sts.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 7) sts. at beg.

of next row. 37 (40, 45, 49, 54, 56) sts. Complete to match Left Front from **.

SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 49 (49, 51, 53, 53, 55) sts.

Work in rib as for Back for 8 cm., (3¼ ins.) ending with a w.s. row.

Change to 4 mm. Needles.

Starting with a K. row, work in st.st. as follows:-

Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every foll. 10th (10th, 10th, 10th, 8th, 8th) row until there are 57 (69, 69, 71, 63, 61) sts.

1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every foll. 12th (12th, 12th, 10th, 10th) row until there are 67 (71, 73, 75, 77) sts.

All Sizes

Cont. straight until Sleeve measures 45 (45, 46, 46, 46, 47) cm, 17¾ (17¾, 18, 18, 18, 18½) ins., ending with a w.s. row.

Shape Top

Cast off 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 7) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. 59 (59, 61, 61, 63, 63) sts. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next 3 rows, then on every foll. alt. row to 31 sts., then on foll. 9 rows, ending with a w.s. row. Cast off rem. 13 sts.

FRONT BORDERS

(Both Alike)

Using 3¼ mm. Needles and with r.s. facing, pick up and knit 33 (35, 35, 37, 37, 39) sts. along front opening edge, between cast-on edge and start of front slope shaping.

Starting with rib row 2, work in rib as given for Back for 3 rows.

Cast off in rib.

RIGHT FRONT TIE AND FRONT BAND

Join shoulder seams by top sewing.

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 7 sts.

Row 1: (rs) K2, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 2: (K1, P1) 3 times, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib until Tie measures 50cm, 19½ ins., ending with a w.s. row.**

This section completes right front tie.

Place marker at beg. of last row.

Cont. in rib until Band, when slightly stretched, fits up left front slope, from cast-off edge of Border to shoulder seam, across back neck and down left front slope to cast off edge of Border, sewing in place as you go along and ending with a w.s. row. Cast off in rib.

LEFT FRONT TIE

Work as for Right Front Tie and Front Band to **.

Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Join side seams by top sewing, enclosing one end of Left Front Tie in left side seam, level with start of front slope shaping. Join sleeve seams by top sewing. Insert sleeves. Cut ribbon into 2 equal lengths. Attach one length to left front opening edge of Front Band, and other length to inside of right side seam level with start of front slope shaping.
