



Cowl

To Make

With 10mm (US 15) needles, cast on 30 sts.

Now work in cable patt as follows:

1st row P2, [k2, p2] twice, k10, [p2, k2] twice, p2.

2nd row P to end.

3rd to 6th rows Rep the last 2 rows twice more.

7th row P2, [k2, p2] twice, slip next 6 sts onto cable needle and hold to front of work, [k1, m1] twice, k2, then k6 from cable needle, [p2, k2] twice, p2. 32 sts.

8th row P to end.

9th row P2, [k2, p2] twice, k12, [p2, k2] twice, p2.

10th row P to end.

11th to 20th rows Rep 9th and 10th rows 5 times.

21st row P2, [k2, p2] twice, C12F, [p2, k2] twice, p2.

22nd row P to end.

Rep the 9th to 22nd rows until work measures approximately 170cm/67in long, ending with a 20th row.

Next row P2, [k2, p2] twice, slip next 6 sts onto cable needle and hold to front of work, [k2tog] twice, k2, then k6 from cable needle, [p2, k2] twice, p2. 30 sts.

Next row P to end.

Next row P2, [k2, p2] twice, k10, [p2, k2] twice, p2.

Next row P to end.

Cast off in patt.

Join the cast on edge to cast off edge to form a ring. If you prefer, the piece can be left unjoined and used as a scarf.

Measurements

Approximately 23cm/9in wide by
170cm/67in long

Materials

* Six 50g balls of Debbie Bliss Paloma in
Burnt Orange 17.

* Pair of 10mm (US 15) knitting needles.

* Cable needle.

Tension

12 sts and 18 rows to 10cm/4in square over
st st using 10mm (US 15) needles.

Abbreviations

C12F = slip next 6 sts onto cable needle
and hold to front of work, k6, then k6 from
cable needle.
