



Crochet Bracelets

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Crochet bracelets are perfect for the summer. Make in your favourite colour cotton yarn and wear all summer, on the beach, in the sea and in the swimming pool – a great souvenir of the holidays. You can then make another next summer in new colours.

SIZES

An average female adult wrist – but adjust for smaller and larger sizes.

Chain stitch bracelet (35in/89cm)
Puff stitch bracelet (7.5in/19cm) long
(1.25in/3cm) deep

YOU WILL NEED

Rico Creative Cotton Print Aran
(85m per 50g ball)
1 x 15mm button

wooden bead
4mm hook
Tapestry needle

ABBREVIATIONS

St = stitch, sts = stitches, ch = chain, dc = double crochet, htr = half treble tr = treble, sl st = slip stitch
rep = repeat.

Puff stitch – (yo, insert yarn in st and draw a long loop through) 3 times in the same stitch, yo, and draw a loop through all 7 loops on hook.

Chain stitch bracelet

Using your yarn and 4mm hook ch 155 sts, sl st in 5th ch from hook, turn, work 8dc into loop. Fasten off and weave in ends.

At the opposite end to the loop, sew a ** button securely. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Wrap the bracelet around your wrist and fasten with the button.

Puff stitch bracelet

Leave a long tail of yarn before you take your 4mm hook ch 36 sts.

Row 1: Dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc to end, turn. (35sts).

Row 2: 1ch, dc to end, turn (35sts).

Row 3: 2ch, 1 puff in dc at base of the ch, * 1ch, miss 1dc, 1 puff in next dc: rep from * to end, turn. (18 puff sts).

Row 4: 1ch, dc in top of puff st, *dc in ch, dc in top of next puff st, rep from * to end.

Row 5: 1ch, dc to end, ch 5 sts, fasten off leaving a tail, then using your tapestry needle sew the end of the chain sts to the end of the bracelet to form a loop.

Take the long tail of yarn which you had at the beginning, put your hook into the first ch of your work, pull through one loop and then ch 5 sts, fasten off and sew to create another loop at the base of the bracelet. Sew two buttons onto the other end of the bracelet so that they correspond to the loops.

Flower Bracelet

Flower

Using your yarn and 4mm hook, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: 1ch, 8dc into ring, sl st in ch.

Rnd 2: [5ch, sl st in next dc, sl st in next dc] rep 4 times.

Rnd 3: Work into each ch loop [1dc, 1htr, 6tr, 1htr, 1dc] Fasten off and weave in ends.

Sew a bead into the centre of the flower.

Bracelet

Using your yarn and 4mm hook 32ch.

Row 1: 1htr in 2nd ch from hook, htr in each ch to end, turn. (30sts)

Rows 2- 3: 2ch, htr to end. (30sts).

Do not fasten off yarn but work down the short side of the bracelet at one end, 2sl st, 5ch to create loop. 2sl st to end. Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew a button on the other end of the bracelet to correspond to the button loop.

Sew the flower securely to the centre of the bracelet. Wear with pride.
