YARN

Big Wool Colour

Version 1

A Fairground 102 2 x 100gm

B Carousel 106 1 x 100gm

Version 2

A Fete 101 2 x 100gm

B carousel 106 1 x 100gm

NEEDLES

1 pair 10mm (no 000) (US 15) needles

TENSION

9 sts and 12½ rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 10mm (US 15) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf is 16 cm (6½ in) wide and 157 cm (62 in) long (excluding pompons).

SCARF

Using 10mm (US 15) needles and yarn A cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Inc once knitwise in each of first 3 sts, K1. 7 sts.

Row 2: Inc purlwise in each st to end. 14 sts.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: K1, P12, K1.

Last 2 rows form patt.

Work in patt for a further 6 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

*Break off yarn A and join in yarn B.

Work 16 rows.

Break off yarn B and join in yarn A.**

Work 16 rows.

Rep from * 4 times more, then from * to ** again.

Work 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. (Scarf should meas 155 cm.)

Next row (RS): (K2tog) 7 times. 7 sts.

Next row: K1, (P2tog) 3 times.

Cast off rem 4 sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the ball band.

Using yarn A, make two 8 cm diameter pompons and attach to ends of scarf.
