

Lumio – Animals hats for kids

Skill level – intermediate

Hat Size

Hats for head circumference 48-52 (54) cm

Hat size 50 cm, 19 cm deep (without Earflaps)

Yarn (Colours, as pictured)

Frog

1 ball (150g) of Schachenmayr original Lumio neon green 00070

1 ball (150g) of Schachenmayr original Lumio marine 00050

A small amount of white superchunky yarn for the eyes

Owl

1 ball (150g) of Schachenmayr original Lumio pink 00035

1 ball (150g) of Schachenmayr original Lumio neon orange 00025

1 ball (150g) of Schachenmayr original Lumio neon green 00070

1 ball (150g) of Schachenmayr original Lumio marine 00050

A small amount of white superchunky yarn for the eyes

Additional Requirements

Crochet hook size 9 mm

Thick wool embroidery needle

Instructions

Abbreviations:

beg = beginning
ch = chain
dc(s) = double crochet
htr = half treble
rep = repeat
Rnd = round
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
tr = treble

Tension

6htr and 5 Rows using 9mm hook = 10 x 10cm Stitch Pattern
(multiple of 4 sts + 3)

Basic Hat

Using 9mm hook make 4 ch and sl st to first ch to form ring
Rnd 1: 2 ch, crochet 10 htr into ring
Rnd 2: 2 ch, work 2 htr into each st to end, sl st into top of 2 ch at beg of rnd. 20 sts
Rnd 3: 2 ch work 1 htr into each st to end, sl st into top of 2 ch at beg of rnd. 20 sts.
Rnd 4: 2 ch, *1 htr into next st, 2 htr into next st; rep from * to end, sl st into 2 ch at beg of rnd. 30 sts.
Rnd 5: As rnd 3, Increasing 2 sts evenly over rnd. 32 sts
Rnds 6 to 9: As rnd 3. 32 sts
Now make earflap; sl st into first 5 sts, 2 ch (does not count as st) and htr into next 6 sts.
Turn, 2 ch, htr first 2 sts together, htr into next 2sts and htr

last 2 sts together. 4 sts.

Turn, 2 ch and htr first 2 sts together and last two sts together. 2 sts.

Turn, 2 ch and htr last 2 sts together, cut the thread and pull through to fasten off.

Work second earflap in same way on the opposite side. (10sts inbetween each earflap, at both front and back)

Join yarn at centre back, sl st around entire edge of hat, including earflaps. Fasten off.

Ties for earflaps; attach 3 threads, 6cm long or longer if preferred, to tip and plait to form braids. Knot ends securely and trim neatly.

Frog

Work Basic Hat in neon green.

Eyes work in white, crochet 2 ch and work 8 dcs into first ch from hook, sl st to first st to form ring.

2nd Rnd in white: 1 ch, work 2 trs into each st. 16 sts.

3rd Rnd in neon green: sl st into each st to end. Cut thread, pull through the last st and secure end.

For the pupil; in marine, crochet 2 ch and work 6 dcs into the first ch from hook, sl st to first st to form ring, fasten off. Sew the pupil onto the eye, see photo.

Sew eyes onto the front of the hat using picture as a guide.

Mouth Work in marine, embroider a smile in ch st using picture as guide.

Owl

Work basic hat, in neon Orange Rnd 1, then for Rnds 2-6 alternate each Rnd in neon green and neon Orange . Rnds 7-9 in neon pink.



The eyes as for the "Frog".

For the beak in neon Orange, 3 ch and into first ch 2htr. 3 sts. Turn, 2 ch, htr into each st. 3 sts. Cut the thread, pull through the last st and sew on beak.

For the ears in neon pink crochet 3 ch and into first ch 2htr. 3 sts. Turn, 2 ch and htr into each st. 3 sts. Turn, 2 ch and work 2htr into first st, 1htr, 2htr into last st. 5 sts.

Fasten off then sew the ears next to the top of the hat, see photo.

Sew threads as "Tufts" on to top as desired.
