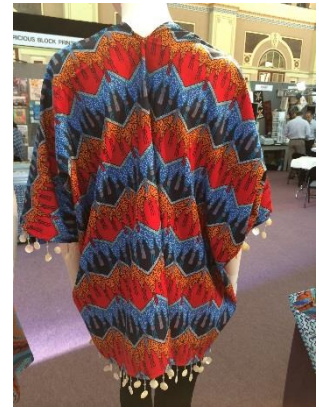




SIMPLE KIMONO – Free pattern

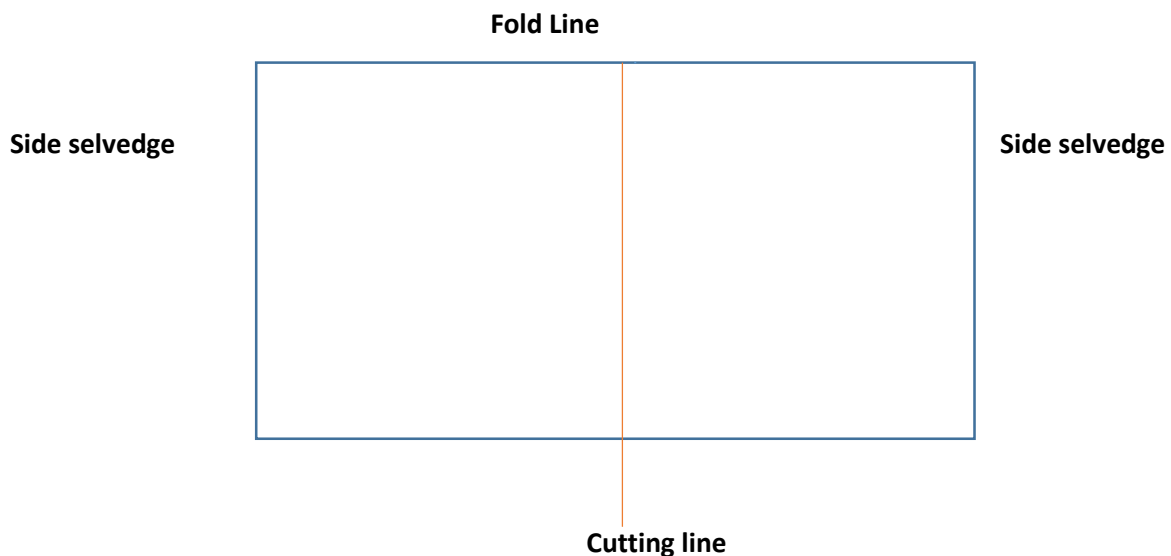
Materials –

- 1.5m Rowan/Freespirit printed cotton
- Coats thread
- 3m trimmings



Instructions –

- Open fabric out flat and fold fabric length in half, wrong sides together laying side selvedge on top of itself. Fold again into quarters, (selvedges together) and press to create a centre fold.
- Open out the last fold and carefully cut the TOP LAYER only from the bottom edge to the centre point of the remaining fold along the pressed crease guideline.



- Turn over the cut edge twice and stitch in place to neaten the inner edge of the kimono.
- Turn fabric inside out , right side together.
- Work a 1cm seam up each side edge leaving a gap of 8” for the armhole opening. Press.
- To attach the trimming, turn under and stitch a 1cm fold along bottom and sleeve hems. Stitch your trim with the tape on the **inside** of the hem and with the trim hanging below the bottom edges. **Your kimono is now complete!**
