Balaclava

F050 Snuggly Tiny Tots DK

Main shade 993 1 1 1 1 2 2 50g balls

Contrast shade 929 1 1 1 1 1 1 50g ball

Helmet

F050 Snuggly Tiny Tots DK

Main shade 989 1 1 2 2 2 2 50g balls

Contrast shade 991 1 1 1 1 1 1 50g ball

Textured T-Bag

F050 Snuggly Tiny Tots DK

Main shade 992 1 1 1 1 1 1 50g ball

Contrast shade 993 1 1 1 1 1 1 50g ball

Snowflake T-Bag

F050 Snuggly Tiny Tots DK

Main shade 991 1 1 2 2 2 2 50g balls

Contrast shade 929 1 1 1 1 1 1 50g ball

Also suitable for Snuggly DK, Snuggly Kisses DK, Snuggly Baby Bamboo DK, Snuggly Baby Crofter DK, Snuggly Pearls DK, Snuggly Smiley Stripes DK and Snuggly White Whispers DK. Amounts may vary.

The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used.

You will also need 1 Pair of 4mm (UK8 – USA6) Knitting Needles, 1 Pair of 3¼mm (UK10 – USA3) Knitting Needles. Stitch Holders and 1 Button for Helmet.

## TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm, (4in) over stocking stitch on 4mm needles or the size required to give correct tension.

Check your tension – if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.

**IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**C** contrast, **cm** centimetres, **cont** continue, **dec** decrease(ing), **DK** double knitting, **g** grammes, **in** inch(es), **inc** increase(ing), **k** knit, **M** main, **mm** millimetres, **0** no stitches, **p** purl, **patt** pattern, **rem** remain(ing), **rep** repeat, **rs** right side, **st(s)** stitch(es), **s1p** slip 1 stitch purlways, **tog** together, **ws** wrong side, **ybk** yarn back, **yfwd** yarn forward, **yrn** yarn round needle, **yft** yarn front.

When working in more than one colour, where possible the colour not in use should be stranded loosely across back of work to retain elasticity of fabric. Where stranding becomes difficult use separate balls of yarn for each colour change and twist the colour to be used round the colour just used to link colours.

### Circle the size you wish to make

holder. Do not break off yarn. 60 sts.

### BALACLAVA

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 67 [75:83:87:91:95] sts.

**1st Row.** \* K1, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**2nd Row.** P1, \* k1, p1, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **1x1 rib**.

Work in 1x1 rib and stripe sequence as follows:-

Work 2 rows in M, 2 rows in C, 4 rows in M, 2 rows in C and 3 rows in M.

### For 1st size only

**16th Row.** Using M (throughout), rib 4, slip these 4 sts onto a stitch holder, rib 30, pick up loop between last and next st and knit into the back of this loop (this will now be referred to as **m1**), rib 29, slip next 4 sts onto a stitch

### For 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

**16th Row.** Using M (throughout), rib 4, slip these 4 sts onto a stitch holder, rib [9:5:7:8:7], rib2tog, (rib [10:6:6:9:7], rib2tog) [4:8:8:6:8] times, rib [8:4:6:7:6], slip next 4 sts onto a stitch holder. Do not break off yarn. [62:66:70:76:78] sts.

### For all 6 sizes

With rs facing, using 4mm needles, work across rem 60 [62:66:70:76:78] sts as follows:-

**1st Row.** Knit.

**2nd Row.** Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until balaclava measures 19 [20:22:23:25:26]cm, (7½ [8:8¾:9:9¾:10¼]in), ending with a ws

### Shape Top

**Next Row.** Cast off 20 [21:22:23:25:26] sts, k19 [19:21:23:25:25], cast off 20 [21:22:23:25:26] sts, break off yarn.

With ws facing, rejoin yarn to rem 20 [20:22:24:26:26] sts and purl to end.

Cont without shaping until balaclava measures 9 [9:10:11:11:12]cm, (3½

[3½:4:4¼:4¼:4¾]in), from cast off sts, ending with a ws row.

Leave these 20 [20:22:24:26:26] sts on a stitch holder.

### Face Border

Join side edges at top of balaclava to 20 [21:22:23:25:26] cast off sts. With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles and M, starting at right side of front, rib across 4 sts left on a stitch holder,

pick up and knit 37 [39:44:47:50:52] sts evenly along right side of balaclava, work across 20 [20:22:24:26:26] sts left on a stitch holder at top of balaclava as follows:- k3 [3:4:4:4:4], k2tog, (k4 [4:4:5:6:6], k2tog) twice, k3 [3:4:4:4:4], pick up and knit 37 [39:44:47:50:52] sts evenly along left side of balaclava and rib across 4 sts left on a stitch holder. 99 [103:115:123:131:135] sts. Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work in stripe sequence as follows:-  
Work 2 rows in M, 2 rows in C, 3 rows in M. Cast off in rib.

## TO MAKE UP

Join front neck and face border seams. See ball band for washing and care instructions.

## HELMET

### EAR FLAPS

#### RIGHT EAR FLAP

##### Strap

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 8 sts.

**1st Row.** K3, p2, k3.

**2nd Row.** K1, p2, k2, p2, k1.

1st and 2nd rows set 2x2 rib and g-st edges. Rep 1st and 2nd rows once more.

**Next Row. (Buttonhole Row).** K3, yfwd, yrn, p2tog, k3.

Cont in patt until strap measures 3 [3:3:4:4:5]cm, (1¼ [1¼:1¼:1½:1½:2]in), ending with a ws row.

**Next Row.** K1, pick up loop between last and next st and knit into the back of this loop (this will now be referred to as **m1**), rib to last st, m1, k1. 10 sts.

**Next Row.** K1, rib to last st, k1.

Rep last 2 rows 7 times more. 24 sts.

**Next Row.** K3, (p2, k2) 5 times, k1.

**Next Row.** K1, (p2, k2) 5 times, p2, k1.

Rep last 2 rows until ear flap measures 3 [3:3:4:5:5]cm, (1¼ [1¼:1¼:1½:2]in), from last inc row, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row.** K1, (p2, k2tog) 5 times, p2, k1. 19 sts.

Leave these 19 sts on a stitch holder.

#### LEFT EAR FLAP

Work as given for Right Ear Flap omitting buttonhole.

## MAIN SECTION

Using 4mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 78 [82:90:98:102:106] sts.

**1st Row.** \* K2, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**2nd Row.** P2, \* k2, p2, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **2x2 rib**.

Work in 2x2 rib and stripe sequence as follows:-

Work 2 rows in C, 2 rows in M and 2 rows in C.

Using M cont in 2x2 rib until work measures

5 [5:5:6:6:6]cm, (2 [2:2:2½:2½:2½]in), ending with 1st row of rib.

### Join Earflaps

**Next Row.** Rib 8 [9:10:11:12:12], holding rs of Left Ear Flap at back of work (rib tog first st of Left Ear Flap with next st of Main Section) 19 times, rib 24 [26:32:38:40:44], holding rs of Right Ear Flap at back of work (rib tog first st of Right Ear Flap with next st of Main Section) 19 times, rib 8 [9:10:11:12:12].

78 [82:90:98:102:106] sts.

Change to 3¼mm needles and cont in 2x2 rib until Main Section measures 8 [8:8:9:9:9]cm, (3 [3:3:3½:3½:3½]in), ending with 2nd row of rib.

**Next Row.** Purl to end inc 2 sts evenly across row for 1st size only and dec 2 sts evenly across row for 2nd and 4th sizes only.

80 [80:90:96:102:106] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

**1st Row.** Knit.

**2nd Row.** Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until Main Section measures 14 [15:16:17:18:18]cm, (5½ [6:6¼:6½:7:7]in), ending with a rs row.

**Next Row.** Purl to end dec 1 st in centre of row for 1st and 2nd sizes only and inc 0 [0:1:1:1:3] sts evenly across row for 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only. 79 [79:91:97:103:109] sts.

### Shape Crown

**1st Row.** K1, (k2tog, k4) 13 [13:15:16:17:18] times. 66 [66:76:81:86:91] sts.

Starting with 2nd row of st-st work 5 rows more.

**7th Row.** K1, (k2tog, k3) 13 [13:15:16:17:18] times. 53 [53:61:65:69:73] sts.

Starting with 2nd row of st-st work 3 rows more.

**11th Row.** K1, (k2tog, k2) 13 [13:15:16:17:18] times. 40 [40:46:49:52:55] sts.

**12th Row.** Purl.

**13th Row.** K1, (k2tog, k1) 13 [13:15:16:17:18] times. 27 [27:31:33:35:37] sts.

**14th Row.** Purl.

**15th Row.** K1, (k2tog) 13 [13:15:16:17:18] times. 14 [14:16:17:18:19] sts.

**16th Row.** (P2tog) 7 [7:8:8:9:9] times, p0 [0:0:1:0:1]. 7 [7:8:9:9:10] sts.

Break off yarn, run yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

## TO MAKE UP

Join back seam reversing sewing for turnback. Make a pompom and attach to top of hat.

Sew on button. Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions

## TEXTURED T-BAG HAT

### Tension

24 sts and 44 rows to 10cm, (4in), over patt on 4mm needles.

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 90 [94:98:106:110:114] sts.

**1st Row.** \* K2, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**2nd Row.** P2, \* k2, p2, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **2x2 rib**.

Cont in 2x2 rib until work measures 10 [10:10:11:11:11]cm, (4 [4:4:4¼:4¼:4¼]in), ending with 2nd row of 2x2 rib.

**Next Row.** P4 [4:3:4:2:4], p2tog, (p8 [12:13:14:11:11], p2tog) 8 [6:6:6:8:8] times, p4 [4:3:4:2:4].

81 [87:91:99:101:105] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

**1st Row.** Using C, knit.

**2nd Row.** As 1st row.

**3rd Row.** Using M, \* k1, s1p, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**4th Row.** K1, \* yft, s1p, ybk, k1, rep from \* to end.

These 4 rows set patt.

Working in patt (throughout) cont until hat measures 23 [24:25:26:27:27]cm, (9 [9½:9¾:10¼:10¾:10¾]in), ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

## TO MAKE UP

Join back seam reversing sewing for 6 [6:6:7:7:7]cm, (2½ [2½:2½:2¾:2¾:2¾]in), for turnback. Placing back seam to centre, sew crown seam. Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

## SNOWFLAKE T-BAG

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 90 [94:98:106:110:114] sts.

**1st Row.** \* K2, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**2nd Row.** P2, \* k2, p2, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **2x2 rib**.

Cont in 2x2 rib until work measures 10 [10:10:11:11:11]cm, (4 [4:4:4¼:4¼:4¼]in), ending with 2nd row of 2x2 rib.

**Next Row.** P2 [4:6:3:6:8], p2tog, (p4 [4:4:5:4:4], p2tog) 14 [14:14:14:16:16] times, p2 [4:6:3:6:8].

75 [79:83:91:93:97] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

**1st Row.** Knit.

**2nd Row.** Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Work 4 [6:8:8:10:10] rows.

**1st Row.** K25 [27:29:33:34:36]M, 1C, 3M, 1C, 1M, (1C, 2M) 4 times, 1C, 1M, 1C, 3M, 1C, 25 [27:29:33:34:36]M.

**2nd Row.** P26 [28:30:34:35:37]M, 1C, 1M, 1C,

2M, 2C, 2M, 1C, 3M, 1C, 2M, 2C, 2M, 1C, 1M, 1C, 26 [28:30:34:35:37]M.

**3rd Row.** K27 [29:31:35:36:38]M, 1C, 3M, 3C, 2M, 1C, 1M, 1C, 2M, 3C, 3M, 1C, 27 [29:31:35:36:38]M.

**4th Row.** P26 [28:30:34:35:37]M, 1C, 1M, 1C, 2M, 4C, 2M, 1C, 2M, 4C, 2M, 1C, 1M, 1C, 26 [28:30:34:35:37]M.

**5th Row.** K25 [27:29:33:34:36]M, 1C, 3M, 1C, (1M, 2C) twice, 3M, (2C, 1M) twice, 1C, 3M, 1C, 25 [27:29:33:34:36]M.

**6th Row.** P31 [33:35:39:40:42]M, 2C, 2M, 2C, 1M, 2C, 2M, 2C, 31 [33:35:39:40:42]M.

**7th Row.** K25 [27:29:33:34:36]M, 8C, 3M, 3C, 3M, 8C, 25 [27:29:33:34:36]M.

**8th Row.** P26 [28:30:34:35:37]M, 7C, 4M, 1C, 4M, 7C, 26 [28:30:34:35:37]M.

**9th Row.** K26 [28:30:34:35:37]M, 2C, 5M, (1C,

3M) twice, 1C, 5M, 2C, 26 [28:30:34:35:37]M.

**10th Row.** P27 [29:31:35:36:38]M, 2C, 5M, (1C, 2M) twice, 1C, 5M, 2C, 27 [29:31:35:36:38]M.

**11th Row.** K28 [30:32:36:37:39]M, 2C, 5M, (1C, 1M) twice, 1C, 5M, 2C, 28 [30:32:36:37:39]M.

**12th Row.** P29 [31:33:37:38:40]M, 2C, 5M, 1C, 1M, 1C, 5M, 2C, 29 [31:33:37:38:40]M.

**13th Row.** K30 [32:34:38:39:41]M, 6C, 3M, 6C, 30 [32:34:38:39:41]M.

**14th Row.** As 12th row.

**15th Row.** As 11th row.

**16th Row.** As 10th row.

**17th Row.** As 9th row.

**18th Row.** As 8th row.

**19th Row.** As 7th row.

**20th Row.** As 6th row.

**21st Row.** As 5th row.

**22nd Row.** As 4th row.

**23rd Row.** As 3rd row.

**24th Row.** As 2nd row.

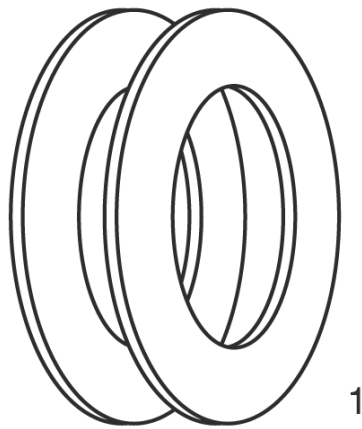
**25th Row.** K25 [27:29:33:34:36]M, 1C, 3M, 1C, 1M, (1C, 2M) 4 times, 1C, 1M, 1C, 3M, 1C, 25 [27:29:33:34:36]M.

Using M only cont until hat measures 23 [24:25:26:27:27]cm, (9 [9½:9¾:10¼:10¾:10¾]in), ending with a ws row.

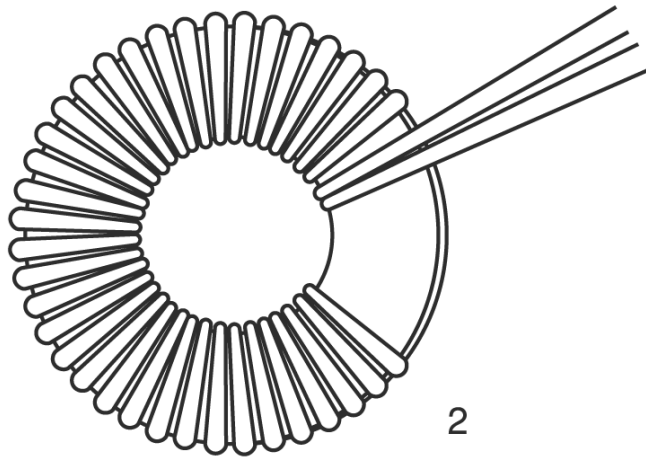
Cast off.

#### TO MAKE UP

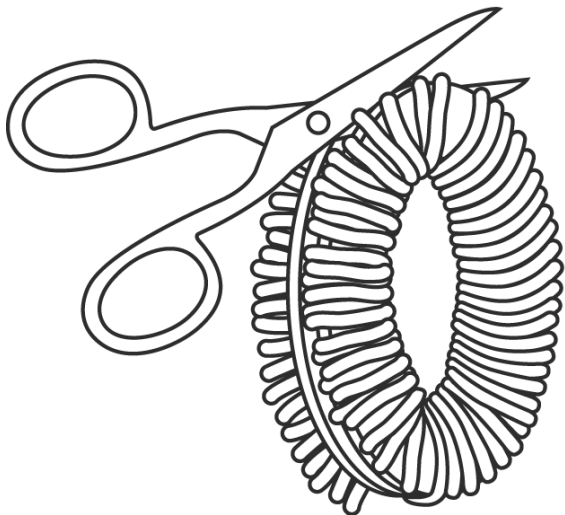
Join back seam reversing sewing for 6 [6:6:7:7:7]cm, (2½ [2½:2½:2¾:2¾:2¾]in), for turnback. Placing back seam to centre, sew crown seam. Make 2 pompoms and attach to top corners of hat. Cover with a damp cloth



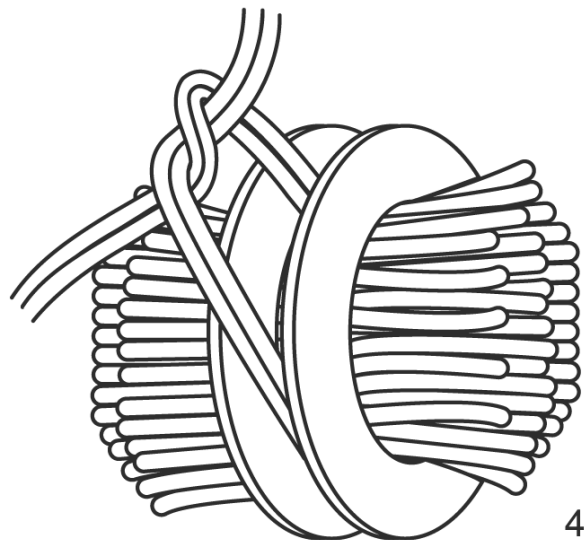

Pompom Diagram

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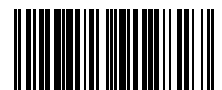
